### Nicole Kupchik MN, RN, CCNS, CCRN, PCCN-CMC, Critical Care Specialist

Nicole has been a Critical Care RN for over 20 years. Graduating from Purdue University with an Associate Degree in Nursing, in 2002 she received her Baccalaureate degree from the University of Washington, Bothwell. In 2008 she received a Master's Degree in nursing specializing as a Clinical Nurse Specialist from the University of Washington Seattle. Nicole has worked at many large academic facilities throughout the United States. In 2001 she accepted a position at Harborview Medical Center in the Neuro-Surgical ICU and Cardiac ICU. She was part of a team to implement one of the first therapeutic hypothermia after cardiac arrest protocols in the U.S. She has been honored with the Washington State March of Dimes, Nurse of the Year Award in Research & Innovation.

In 2007 she became a critical care educator, the following year she accepted the role of Clinical Nurse Specialist for cardiology, critical care and founded the sepsis program. Through her leadership Harborview Medical Center's sepsis program has been honored with 2 Washington State Qualis Awards for Patient Safety & Clinical Leadership.
